ELECTIONS

ELECTIONS – Scheduled Elections for 2022 – Primary Election August 2, 2022 and the General Election on November 8, 2022. Absent Voter Ballots are available by pickup or mail for each election. You have to complete an application prior to receiving the ballot. Contact the Hall at (989) 856-2102 to get an application. You can also ask to be put on the permanent absent voter list and then you will automatically be mailed an application for each election.

Trash, Brush & Spring Clean Up

BRUSH PICK-UP: 1st Wednesday of each month **April thru November** Light yard work & trimming. Set branches out with cut end to the curb. Call (989) 856-4407 with questions.

LEAF COLLECTION: **April & May.** The DPW will collect each week as needed. A final sweep will be done following the Memorial Day Weekend.

GRASS AND WEEDS MAINTENANCE: Please cut the lawn or make arrangements to do it. If the City mows, the bill begins at \$200 per hour. Support a local business instead.

Summer Taxes: Summer taxes will be mailed out July 1 and are due by September 14th. Mortgage escrow companies will also receive a copy of your tax bill, if they have requested it from us. Confirm with your mortgage company that they are paying this bill for you!

Riverside Park: The Michigan DNR Trust fund approved a \$298,800 grant for development of the property. We are waiting on final approval from the legislature and governor. We also received a grant of \$25,000 from the Saginaw Bay WIN for this park. We will install seawall, concrete walkway/fishing pier, additional boat launch, lighting and another canoe/kayak launch. You should see these improvements to the park beginning this year.

Mosquito Control: We again contracted with APM Mosquito Control (877) 276-4714. You can call them for treatment during special events. If you are planning on having an outdoor gathering, call them and they will treat your property prior to your gathering.

PERMITS: (989) 856-6061 for the following: Home Improvements, Soil Erosion & Building Permits are handled by our Zoning Administrator/Building Inspector, Terry Kelly. Josh Zimmerman (989)413-9123 handles electrical inspections, Robert Neymeiyer (989) 225-0717 handles mechanical inspections & Jeff Rowe (989) 553-5675 handles plumbing inspections. Outside Assembly, Entertainment & Vendor Permits call Chief Romzek at (989) 856-3304.

Utility Bills (Contact us to set up email billing and information on how to pay your account online)

Pay ½ or more of the Utility Bill by April 25th and the rest by May 25th without late fees. Pay the "amount due" on the bottom of the first sheet of the bill, that is the total owed. If you used water, but you're NOT billed for consumption, call the Water Plant to have your meter checked. If you wait you will have to pay for the consumption all at once when an actual reading is obtained.

WE NEED YOUR PHONE NUMBER! This helps us to contact you for emergencies (water leaks, frozen pipes, etc.)

REPORT WATER LEAKS - IF YOU SEE OR HEAR WATER running in a building or see standing water on a lot where it usually does not pool, PLEASE CALL THE WATER DEPT (989) 856-4407.
