470.01 SPEED LIMITS ON PIGEON RIVER.

- (a) No operator of a vessel on the waters of the Pigeon River st. Il exceed a slow-no wake speed within the following area of such River: From a line extending from the Huron Yacht Club, in an area commonly referred to as the Tires, extending out and along a northerly direction 100 yards beyond the breakwall, Section 35, Town 18 north, Range 10 east, in the Village.
- (b) The boundaries of the area described in subsection (a) hereof shall be marked with signs and with buoys. All buoys must be placed as provided in a permit issued by the Michigan Department of Natural Resources and be in conformity with the State Uniform Waterway Marking System. (Res. 96-13. Passed 2-12-96.)

470.02 DOCKING PRIVILEGES ON PIGEON RIVER.

(a) Council hereby extends docking privileges for the Huron County Sheriff's Department and for Michigan Department of Natural Resources (MDNR) water patrol boats on Village-controlled property, west of the access for handicapped persons, on the Pigeon River.

- (b) Council hereby grants permission to the Huron County Sheriff's Department and the MDNR to install a dock at the location specified in subsection (a) hereof.
- (c) The MDNR shall be notified in writing of this section, with a copy of this section included. (Res. 96-81. Passed 8-1-96.)

470.99 PENALTY.

Whoever violates any of the provisions of this chapter is responsible for a civil infraction and shall be fined not more than one hundred dollars (\$100.00).
